 - cupbearer to the king." Far from his homeland,

Abigail acted quickly. She took two hundred loaves of bread, two skins of wine, five dressed sheep, five seahs of roasted grain, a hundred cakes of raisins and two hundred cakes of pressed figs, and loaded them on donkeys.

► Be ready in season and out of season. Don't wait for your "big moment." Focus on skill-development instead of accomplishments or accolades.

> You have no idea which skill God will use to elevate you.

David was a talented song writer and musician, but the skill God used to catapult him forward into his destiny was the skill of killing things with a slingshot!

Same for Abigail. It was her ability to "make a lot of food in a hurry" and to stay calm in a crisis that impressed the future King. If she had showed up to meet 400 hungry men, empty handed, I'm not sure it would have turned out as well.

6. HONOR YOUR WORD
